## Your Guide to the EB-5 Process

Here is a step-by-step flowchart explaining the EB-5 immigrant visa (green card) process via an American Consul. Contact Martin J. Lawler for time estimates for each step.

The EB-5 immigrant investor category allows a person and his or her dependent family members to get a green card (i.e., live permanently in the U.S.) by investing in the U.S. and creating or saving 10 U.S. jobs. The minimum amount of money to invest is $\$ 500,000$ (soon to be $\$ 800,000$ ) if invested in a high unemployment or rural area. Otherwise, you must invest at least $\$ 1,000,000$ (soon to be $\$ 1,200,000$ ).

Most invest in limited partnerships called regional centers, and the investment amount including their fee is $\$ 535,000$ to $\$ 560,000$. People can also create their own businesses. EB-5 immigration takes 2 to 3 years in most cases.
